



Cleaning Procedures for Printed Images

- 1) Use a clean, soft, lint-free cloth.
- 2) Use off the shelf glass cleaner WITHOUT AMMONIA (Windex, Glass Plus, etc.).
- 3) Spray the cleaner onto the cloth, **not** onto the image.
- 4) Wipe down the image with the wet (do not over saturate) cloth.
- 5) Dry with a clean soft dry cloth.
- 6) If the edges of the image are not sealed, take care not to introduce cleaner to the adhesive as over time edge lifting will occur.

The decal material used for this project may be cleaned with a normal household glass cleaning solution using a soft cloth. It is also important that chemicals or solvents are not used on the decal material. For example, ammonia, isopropyl alcohol, acetone, gasoline, mineral spirits, paint thinner, MEK, MIBK, Goof Off, ethanol, and other solvents and chemicals can easily damage the decal material. Do not use sharp tools or abrasive cleaning pads on the surface of the decal to avoid scratching.
